WHAT IS NY FORWARD?

NY Forward (NYF) was launched in 2022 and serves as a central component of the State's economic development efforts to accelerate and expand the revitalization of New York's downtowns. NY Forward communities are walkable, less dense areas that serve the immediate local community, and are more local in nature - focusing on the immediately surrounding residential or rural agricultural-centric development.

Through the NYF program, these smaller downtowns receive planning and project implementation support needed to attract more businesses, residents, and visitors, while also providing a higher quality of life for all residents.

Keeseville will has been awarded \$4.5 million to implement projects as one of the North Country's recipients of NY Forward funding!
